13 That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. 2 Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. 3 Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. 4 As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. 5 Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. 6 But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. 7 Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. 8 Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. 9 Whoever has ears, let them hear."

The crowd that gathered around him was so large that he got into a boat and sat in it out on the lake, while all the people were along the shore at the water's edge. 2 He taught them many things by parables, and in his teaching said: 3 "Listen! A farmer went out to sow his seed. 4 As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. 5 Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. 6 But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. 7 Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants, so that they did not bear grain. 8 Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, some multiplying thirty, some sixty, some a hundred times." 9 Then Jesus said, "Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear."

8 After this, Jesus traveled about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. The Twelve were with him, **2** and also some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases: Mary (called Magdalene) from whom seven demons had come out; **3** Joanna the wife of Chuza, the manager of Herod's household; Susanna; and many others. These women were helping to support them out of their own means.**4** While a large crowd was gathering and people were coming to Jesus from town after town, he told this parable: **5** "A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path; it was trampled on, and the birds ate it up. **6** Some fell on rocky ground, and when it came up, the plants withered because they had no moisture. **7** Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up with it and choked the plants. **8** Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up and yielded a crop, a hundred times more than was sown."When he said this, he called out, "Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear."

The SOWER is God

DID YOU KNOW?

- Omniscient Having complete or unlimited knowledge, awareness, or understanding; perceiving all things.
- **Omnipresent** Present everywhere at the same time.
- Omnipotent Almighty or infinite in power. Having great or unlimited authority or power.

SOIL #1 - "THE PATH"

- Hears the Word but doesn't understand
- Hardened heart (trampled)
- No desire to learn more closed minded unreceptive
- The devil rips away the seed before it can have any effect

SOIL #Z - "ROCKY PLACES"

- Hears the Word and understands
- Shallow (no root)
- Surface enthusiasm
- Shares excitement and belief with others but without roots they fade away at first sign of difficult circumstances or persecution. (time of testing)
- Scorched by the sun (can't handle the heat)

SOIL #3 - "THORNY GROUND"

- Hears the Word but refuses to give up their love of the "world"
- Concerned with what others think
- Worry rules their life and chokes out their faith
- Greed and materialistic things occupy their focus
- Seeking to live a life luxury over a life of righteousness
- Shared the soil with the thorns and the thorns choked out the plant

Wrap-up

- The condition of our heart determines how we receive God's Word
- Not all people that hear the Word will understand and believe
- This parable opens up the door to the rest of Jesus' teachings
- Growth and change
- Once the seed of the word of God is sown, only time will show how a person's faith will grow and develop (fruit)
- If no fruit is seen, the issue is with the soil and never with the seed.

SOIL #4 - "GOOD SOIL"

- Hears the Word and received it
- Lives it (bears fruit)
- Endures with honesty and goodness
- Humility and patience through growth
- Seeks continual growth and increases fruit
